Regarding observations and recommendation of Committee on Public Accounts in 82 Report for Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for Scheduled Castes and Other Backward Classes students –

Kindly refer to the subject cited above.

As per observation and recommendations of Committee on Public Accounts in 82 Report and for smooth and proper implementation of Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for Scheduled Castes and Other Backward Classes students, it is requested that following instructions be implemented in strict compliance and send the Action Taken Report:-

- (i) Effective steps to identify eligible beneficiaries for the scheme be initiated and a data base be prepared for future planning.
- (ii) Ensure that maximum number of students in the State are benefitted from the scheme in future.
- (iii) The public representatives be involved to the extent possible to give them important role in planning/implementation of scheme.
- (iv) An effective system to address all deficiencies pointed out by audit, be devised so that such serious defaults are not repeated in future.
- (v) Effective system be devised to ensure timely payment of scholarship to the concerned students in future.
- (vi) Verification of Aadhar be made mandatory before making payment in future.



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- (vii) Ensure availability of proper infrastructure in institutes.
- (viii) Matter regarding misuse of funds be got investigated in detail.
- (ix) Annual inspection of institutes be conducted and in all cases where written complaints received from students, FIRs, if required be got registered.
- (x) Proper system of authentication of Aadhar numbers of applicant and checking of payments made to students by banks with reference to sanctions should be evolved.
- (xi) A mechanism for verification of details of all students shown to have studied in institutions with the Universities/Boards registration data should be put in place.
- (xii) Monitoring mechanism in the form of submission of returns by institutes, make a time frame for inspections of educational institutions, and putting in place a grievance redressal mechanism be evolved.
- (xiii) An end to end online system right from uploading the applications to credit of scholarship directly in the beneficiaries accounts instead of routing the funds through intermediate bank accounts be devised and implemented
- (xiv) An effective monitoring mechanism, a time frame for inspections of educational institutions and a grievance redressal mechanism also be put in place in the system.
